The main purpose is to provide safe, accurate and high-quality diagnostic imaging services that support effective clinical diagnosis and treatment, while ensuring compliance with radiation safety standards, regulatory requirements and patient care protocols.

Key Performance Areas

- Perform imaging procedures (x-rays and ultrasounds) to aid in accurate patient diagnoses and follow up so patients receive the correct treatment.
- Assess patient history and clinical indications to determine the most appropriate imaging procedure and technique.
- Interact with patients to offer them psychological support and address their concerns regarding an imaging procedure.
- Prepare and administer contrast media in accordance with clinical protocols and prescribed safety standards.
- Where available, use portable devices to conduct diagnostic scans on patients who cannot move to the radiology unit.
- Monitor patients, ensuring their safety during imaging procedures.
- Log and organize image results, develop films, assist with the interpretation of radiology results, and consult with the doctor to determine if other images need to be taken.
- Maintain proper records of patient details ensuring confidentiality of sensitive information
- Ensure compliance with health and safety guidelines to minimize risk of exposure to ionizing radiation.
- Monitor stock levels, conduct inventory checks and manage radiology consumables to prevent stock-outs and wastage.
- Ensure appropriate maintenance, sterilization, storage and operational readiness of radiology equipment and promptly report faults.
- Maintaining up to date knowledge of current radiology practices.
- Direct and supervise the activities of Radiology assistants and trainee Radiographers
- Assist in timely submission of claims to medical aid and ensuring all part-payments are settled prior to patient leaving hospital.
- Follow Infection Prevention and Control guidelines and universal precaution procedures to ensure compliance with OSHA standards
- Promote and adhere to ABF's procedures, policies and guidelines, including, without limitation, those relating to SHERQ, Competition Law and Antibribery and Corruption (ABC)
- Maintain a professional, empathetic, and patient-first approach to ensure a positive and high-quality service experience for all stakeholders.

Job Requirements

- Diploma in Radiography (Diagnostic Radiography) / Radiologic Technology or equivalent from a recognised institution.
- Competence in diagnostic ultrasound and reporting
- 3 years relevant work experience
- Experience with Radiology Information Systems (RIS), Picture Archiving and Communication Systems (PACS), and other healthcare software applications will be an added advantage
